Membership: Presidential Line, Board Vice Presidents, Assembly Chairs

Membership: Presidential Line, Board Vice Presidents, Assembly Chairs, up to three (3) Public Members

Leadership: Chair, Vice Chair and Secretary of each Assembly **Membership:** All Delegates from each Assembly

Assemblies

State and Regional Societies

Charge: To facilitate communication of and collaboration on the issues affecting the Society's membership at the state and regional level through recommendations to the Board of Directors.

Leadership: Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary elected by Assembly Delegates

Membership: Each approved state and regional society shall be entitled to appoint one (1) Delegate per two hundred fifty (250) Active and Life Active Members within its voting membership up to three (3) Delegates in total

Delegates must be Active Members.

Groups Represented: State and Regional Societies comprised of at least ninety percent (90%) Active and Life Active Members of the Society.

Board Vice President Liaisons: Advocacy and Development

National and Specialty Societies

Charge: To represent the specialty practices within the membership of the Society and facilitate the generation and presentation of recommendations to the Board of Directors reflective of the unique interests, priorities and concerns of the national and specialty societies.

Leadership: Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary elected by Assembly Delegates

Membership: Each approved national and specialty society shall be entitled to appoint one (1) Delegate per two hundred fifty (250) Active and Life Active Members within its voting membership, up to three (3) Delegates in total.

Delegates must be Active Members.

Groups Represented: National and Specialty Societies comprised of at least ninety (90%) Active and Life Active Members of the Society, or otherwise be contractually affiliated with the Society.

Board Vice President Liaisons: Education and Academic Affairs

Member Sections

Charge: To represent the membership of the Society and facilitate the generation and presentation of recommendations to the Board of Directors reflective of the interests, priorities and strategic initiatives of the membership

Leadership: Chair, Vice Chair, Secretary elected

Membership: Each approved Member Special Interest Group ("SIG") shall be entitled to appoint one (1) Delegate per fifty (50) members, up to five (5) Delegates in total.

Delegates do not have to be Active Members, except those elected to Leadership, who must be Active or International members.

Groups Represented: Membership Special Interest Group to be formally created, including converting existing forums into SIGs (e.g. WPS, YPS, PRIDE Forum).

Board Vice President Liaisons: Membership and Research
